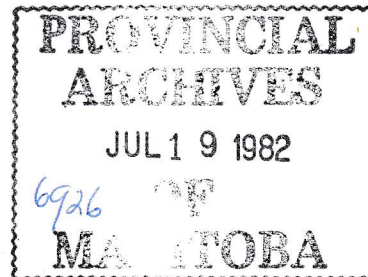


Dear Mr. Brandt:

I understand that you will be giving a course on paper conservation at the University of Victoria from October 14-22, 1982. I was wondering if you might consider stopping en route in Calgary to view part of our collection of works on paper and make some recommendations on their conservation needs. We have been fortunate at last to have a paper technician on staff who will begin the massive task of conserving our approximately 19,000 works on paper. Amongst these is our illustrator art collection, work largely produced on inferior board with a view to disposal once reproduced - they pose a major conservation problem. The technician we have hired is Ann Gardner who I believe studied under you at CCI in Moncton.

We would like to know if you could stop over in Calgary for, say, a day and if so what your fee would be. We hope it will be possible for you to look at the collection.
